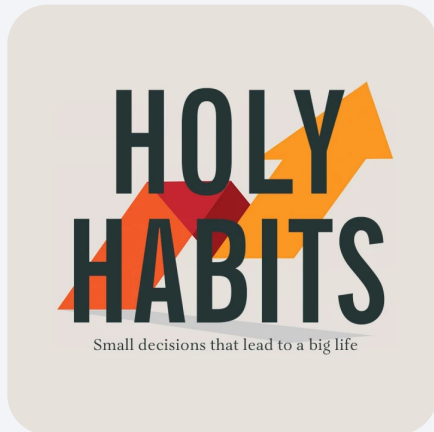

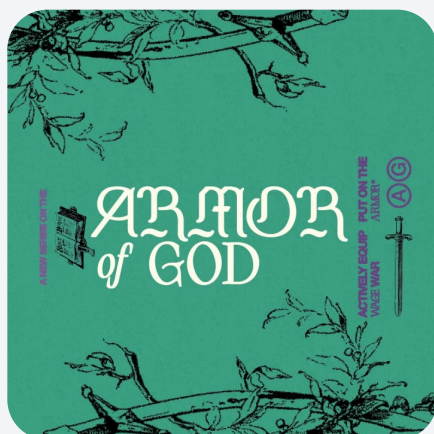

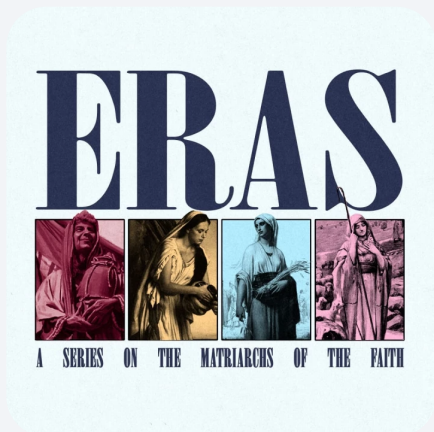
July

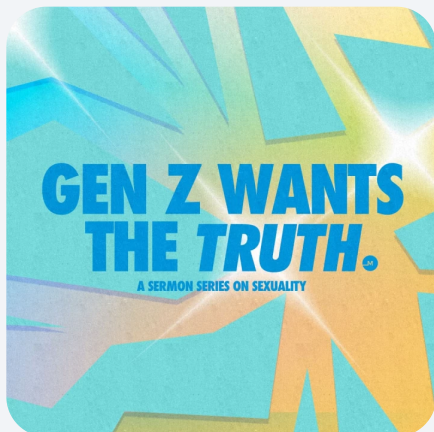
